

ARB/C006/2019 – NEW FREEZING ORDER

IT IS BEING NOTIFIED that by a decree dated 23rd January, 2019 given by the Court of Magistrates (Malta) as a Court of Criminal Inquiry – (Magistrate Dr Josette Demicoli LL.D.). Compilation Number 49/2019 in the case:

(Inspector Kevin Pulis)

Versus

TOMISLAV HEGEDUS, 27 years, son of the late Goran and Sandra née Parnis, born in Pietà, Malta on the 8th of July 1991, residing at Harmony Crt, Flt 4, Triq il-Hmistax ta' Awwissu, Mosta and/or St. Mary Mansions, Fl 2, Triq P. Mallia, Mosta and holder of Maltese Identity Card bearing number 356591(M).

ORDERED the attachment in the hands of third parties in general of all moneys and other movable or immovable property due to or pertaining or belonging to **TOMISLAV HEGEDUS** and prohibits the said accused from transferring, pledging, hypothecating or otherwise disposing of any movable or immovable property and this according to Section 22A of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta, and Section 23A of the Criminal Code, Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court AUTHORIZED the said accused to continue to receive as salary and/or social benefits the amount that does not exceed thirteen thousand, nine hundred and seventy-six Euro and twenty-four cents (€13,976.24) per year after the accused indicates with a note from where they are perceiving this money

Any person who acts in contravention of the court order mentioned in Section 22A and Section 23A referred to above shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine (*multa*) not exceeding eleven thousand and six hundred and forty-six Euro and eighty-seven cents (€11,646.87), or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Any transfer or other disposal of any immovable property made in contravention of the said Court order shall be null and without effect at law.

Kull persuna li tagħmel xi haġa bi ksur tal-ordni tal-Qorti msemmi fl-Artikolu 22A u fl-Artikolu 23A tkun hatja ta' reat u tehel meta tinstab hatja multa ta' mhux iżjed minn ħdax-il elf, sitt mija u sitta u erbghin Euro u sebgħa u tmenin ċenteżmu (€11,646.87) jew prigunerija għal żmien ta' mhux iżjed minn tnax-il xahar, jew dik il-multu u prigunerija flimkien.
